Yá'át'ééh! We hope that each and every one of you are doing well during this difficult time of the COVID-19 pandemic which impacts your everyday lives. We encourage you to stay safe and healthy during this time. Dzilth-Na-O-Dith-Hle Community School is complying with the school closure through the remainder of the 2019 – 2020 Academic Year by Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham, the Navajo Nation President Nez and Navajo Nation Board of Education with regard to the spread of the COVID-19 Novel Coronavirus.

We know that you have several concerns and questions about your child's education during this time. In light of this, we hope that this letter serves to alleviate some of your concerns in regard to your child's education. Majority of the English Language Arts and Math content has been taught this school year through the third quarter. Therefore, the fourth quarter is typically a time to review and practice previously taught content.

Although the school campus is closed, the staff is mandated to provide off-site learning opportunities for your child. In order to maintain your child's learning we hope they will participate in activities with your support. Learning times have been established for each grade level as charted below:

- K – 2nd Grade 40 minutes per day (ELA & Math)
- 3rd – 5th Grade 60 minutes per day (ELA & Math)
- 6th – 8th Grade 80 minutes per day (ELA & Math)

In addition, we are committed to provide the following:

- Gifted & Talented Enrichment Opportunities
- Special Education Services
- Counseling Services

April 13th through May 21, 2020 is the timeline for Off-Site Learning. Classroom teachers and assistants will continue to contact parents by phone, text or email. ***Fourth quarter grades will be determined on a pass/fail basis which will be dependent on parent and student involvement during Off-Site Learning.*** Attached is the staff directory if you do not have the teacher's contact information.

We are asking for your support and commitment as we continue to provide instructional activities/lessons for your child. As we work together, be assured that we are here to assist you with your child's learning needs. We appreciate your cooperation and patience as we work through this difficult time.
